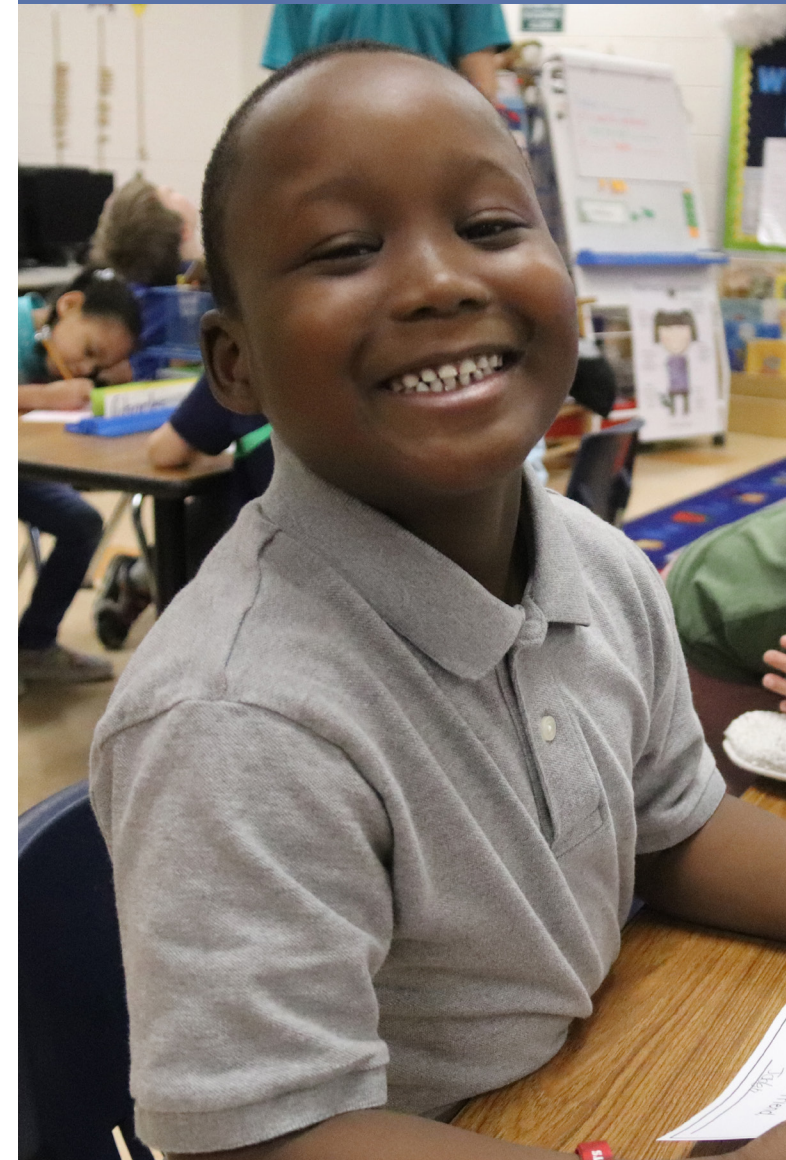

families benefited from our 15 mass food distributions in efforts to offset cost burdens from effects of COVID-19.

**\$1.1M**

pledged by the community to fund programs dedicated to improving access to health, education, and financial stability.
