In the past year, Horry County has endured disasters and hardships. United Way of Horry County pledged to offset these occurrences to help improve the lives of those in our community.

\$165,000

granted and dispersed for disaster relief from Hurricane Florence flooding.

\$237,000

raised so far in COVID-19 Relief Funding and used to assist individuals affected from the pandemic.

6,000

families benefited from our 15 mass food distributions in efforts to offset cost burdens from effects of COVID-19.
